- Eltham - Soldiers park (Note: these toilets close at dusk and do not open again until dawn) Conway Road (if heading North - first road on the left) Park outside the park
- Kaponga – Victoria Park, Victoria Street Park on street alongside Victoria Park
- Manaia Main Street (State Highway 45) Park on Street outside toilets
- Opunake (by Medical Centre) Napier/King Street Corner Park on street either on Napier Street or King Street
- Opunake - Recreation Ground Main Street - Opposite High School Park on the main street
- Rahotu – In grounds of Methodist Church Main Road Park on the roadside
